Nursery Theme for December

Our focus for December is Christmas. The children will be learning a selection of Christmas songs for our Christmas Concert. They further be developing creative skills by using a wide variety of cutting, writing, painting and drawing media. They will be writing letters to Santa and sending Christmas cards. We will be introducing our Wonder Wall when the children are encouraged to ask questions about the topic.

Scissor Skills

The children are having opportunities to use scissors and develop their cutting skills. It would be great if your child had an opportunity to develop these skills at home (under your watchful eye). So if you don't already have a pair of children's scissors why not send a last minute request to Santa for a pair!

Physical Development

We are continuing to learn our outside rules and routines, focusing on safety and fun. Our focus will be on developing children's fundamental movement skills. They will develop their jumping skills through activities from the Mini Moves Programme. We are also planning to teach the children a range of traditional games over the coming weeks and will initially be focusing on Hopscotch and What Time is Mr Wolf?

Numeracy

We will be talking about time, including night time, day time, seasons, the number of sleeps until the Christmas and ordering our school day and other events. Our colour focus for December will be RED being our December focus. We plan to have our red show and tell on 13 December. Children will be observing and talking about 2 D shapes including triangles, circles and squares. We will also be introducing the new shape, a star.
