Return to School

Following the announcement by the NI Executive last week, all children will return to school on Monday 8 March. As some of the children will have been out of our classroom for a period of over three months, we wish to ensure your child feels happy transitioning back into nursery. To do this, we have been considering a range of strategies to support the children's wellbeing. If you feel your child may benefit from calling up to the nursery for a short visit at our school doors prior to the return of the whole class, please contact Ms Acheson or myself as soon as possible so these arrangements can be put in place. We will also be preparing a video in advance to let the children know about the choices available within the classroom upon their return. To ensure the return is a positive experience we will end at 12:00 noon on Monday 8 & Tuesday 9 March, before commencing dinners from the Wednesday 10 March. School will finish at 12:30 pm for the remainder of the week. From 15 March the children will then attend for a normal school day.

Covid Guidelines

In light of the current Covid-19 transmissions, we have updated our policy for dropping off/picking up at nursery:

- Please ensure you enter and exit the premises via the designated route for your child's class
- All adults must wear a face mask on entering the school gates
- A two metre distance must be observed at all times
- We would encourage one adult per child at drop off/pick up times but if this is not possible, please maintain your family bubble and keep any additional children under strict supervision at all times
- All persons entering the premises should refrain from touching gates and play equipment as areas have been sanitised and allocated to certain bubbles
- Staff will wear masks when meeting and greeting your child at the gates and we would encourage a swift handover
- To ensure the safety of all, please come within the allocated ten minute pick-up/drop-off times
- Avoid congregating within school premises, including school gates this is in line with the Department of Education's regulations
- No items should be brought into nursery from home

We have a duty of care to our school community and pupils and would ask you to adhere to these guidelines – please also brief any childminders/grandparents who are involved in dropping off/collecting your child.

Nursery Theme for March/April

When we return to the classroom our topic is **DINOSAURS**. Along with our collection of toy dinosaurs (both large and small) we have books, posters, painting and sorting materials, clay, dough and cutters, amongst other things, to help us discover and become palaeontologists! We will be sorting and classifying dinosaurs and trying to work out what happened to them.




Literacy

We are continuing to listen for and count syllables in words. Most children are finding one syllable words difficult to recognise and tend to draw out the word as they say it, so we are emphasising these words especially. (E.g. car, boat, house, man, dog).

We are also emphasising how important it is to listen to our friends when they are talking and so will be playing lots of listening games and taking part in lots of circle time activities .

Numeracy

We will be developing our rote and touch counting skills as we count lots of items around nursery. We are singing lots of counting songs too! We are also focusing on the colours green and brown. We are continuing to compare and sort according to size and are encouraging the children to understand and use the vocabulary of length.

We are developing an understanding of positional words—on top, above, below, under etc.

Personal Development

When we return to school we will be continuing our Circle Time focus on feelings and extending these through looking at stories and reading books. We will be revisiting our quiet room rules and Sunshine Rules.
